The Department of Economic Development, having consulted the person concerned, makes the following Order under section 27 of the Petroleum Act 1998 (of Parliament) as it applies to the Isle of Man¹.

1 Title

This Order is the Submarine Pipe-lines (Designated Owner) Order 2013.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald², this Order comes into operation on 19 April 2013.

3 Designated Owner of Pipeline

For the purposes of Part 3 of the Petroleum Act 1998 (submarine pipelines) BGE (UK) Limited, whose registered office is at 5th Floor, 6 St Andrew Street, London EC4A 3AE, is designated as the owner of the pipeline described in the Table.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order designates BGE (UK) Limited as the owner of the submarine pipeline from Loughshinny in the Republic of Ireland to Brighthouse Bay, Scotland for the purposes of Part 3 of the Petroleum Act 1998 (of Parliament) in so far as that Act has effect in relation the Isle of Man and its territorial waters.

This Order replaces the Submarine Pipe-Lines (Designated Owner) (No. 2) Order 1994, which is revoked.
