**AIR NAVIGATION (RESTRICTION OF FLYING) (TT FLYING DISPLAYS)
REGULATIONS 2013**

Coming into operation 1st June 2013

Whereas the Department of Economic Development deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict or prohibit flying in airspace referred to in these Regulations by reason of the intended holding of flying displays.

The Department makes these Regulations under Article 96 of the Air Navigation Order 2005¹, as it has effect in the Isle of Man².

1. Title, commencement and duration

- (1) The title of these Regulations is the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (TT Flying Displays) Regulations 2013.
- (2) These Regulations come into operation on 1st June 2013 and shall cease to have effect at the end of 7th June 2013.

2. Restriction of flying

An aircraft shall not fly at the times and within the airspace specified in columns 1 to 3 of the following table except —

- (a) for the purpose of the flying display specified in column 4 of the table —



- (b) the Commander of the aircraft has the permission of and acts in accordance with any instructions given by the Air Traffic Control Unit at Isle of Man (Ronaldsway) Airport.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations temporarily restrict flying in the areas within which flying displays are to take place on 4th June 2013. Contravention of the restriction is an offence under the Air Navigation Order 2005 (SI 2005/1970) punishable on summary conviction by a fine not exceeding £2,500.

The dates and times when these Regulations are in force will be promulgated in advance by Notice to Airmen (NOTAM).
