Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

GLEN DARRAGH ROAD, MAROWN (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2013

Made: 30 April 2013
Coming into Operation: 20 June 2013

The Department of Infrastructure makes the following Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985.

1 Title

This Order is the Glen Darragh Road, Marown (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2013.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation on 20 June 2013.

3 Restriction on vehicles waiting

No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the roads specified in the Schedule.

4 Exemptions

Nothing in article 3 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable—

- (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- (b) goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle;
- (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a Government Department or local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; or
- (d) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.

Glen Darragh Road		
	East side (i) from its junction with Glen Darragh Gardens for a distance of 230 metres in a south-westerly direction	No waiting at any time
	West side (i) from its junction with the old railway line for a distance of 172 metres in a northerly direction to its junction with Close Veg	No waiting at any time

This Order imposes no waiting restrictions on sections of the east and west sides of Glen Darragh Road, Marown.
