POST TT ROAD RACES (SUSPENSION OF ENACTMENTS) ORDER 2013

Made: 22 May 2013
Coming into Operation: 7 June 2013

The Department of Infrastructure makes the following Order under section 7 of the Road Races Act 1982.

1 Title

This Order is the Post TT Road Races (Suspension of Enactments) Order 2013.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation on 7 June 2013.

3 Interpretation

In this Order—

“**Course**,” “**practice period**” and “**race period**” have the same meanings as in the Road Race Order;

“**promoter**” means the Southern 100 Motorcycle Racing Limited;

“**Road Race Order**” means the Post TT Road Races Order 2013.

4 Suspension of certain road traffic enactments

(1) Section 5 (using vehicle without licence) and section 12 (display of registration mark) of the Licensing and Registration of Vehicles Act 1985 in so far as those sections apply to a vehicle specified in paragraph (2), are suspended for the periods specified in paragraph (3).

(2) The vehicle referred to in paragraph (1) is a motorcycle with or without a sidecar which is—

(a) travelling from the place where it is kept to the start of the race area;

(b) travelling from a point on the race area to the place where it is kept; or

(c) is being used by a travelling marshal.

is subject to the restrictions and conditions specified in paragraph (3).

(3) The authorisation applies to—

(a) the closure period referred to in article 5, and

(b) during a period commencing 3 hours before any practice period or race period and ending 3 hours after that practice period or race period.

5 Provision for the postponement of the road races

In the event of adverse weather conditions or any other circumstances which may occur on 8 June 2013 the road races may be postponed until 9 June 2013 from 1.30 pm until 6.00 pm, and in such event this Order will have effect where the context so admits as if that day were substituted for 8 June 2013.

6 Duration

This Order will be in force from 7 June 2013 up to and including 10 June 2013.

This Order enables a motorcycle accepted for competition in a practice or race to be driven between the place where it is kept and the Post TT Road Races course, although it is not taxed or registered.
