## **ROAD TRAFFIC (DRINK-DRIVING REHABILITATION COURSES) (FEES) ORDER 2013**

*Approved by Tynwald:* 18 June 2013  
*Coming into Operation:* 01 July 2013

The Department of Home Affairs makes the following Order under section 1 of the Fees and Duties Act 1989.

### **1 Title**

This Order is the Road Traffic (Drink-Driving Rehabilitation Courses) (Fees) Order 2013.

### **2 Commencement**

If approved by Tynwald, this Order comes into operation on 01 July 2013.<sup>1</sup>

### **3 Fee payable for a course**

The fee payable by a person required by a court order under paragraph 11(8) of Schedule 3 to the *Road Traffic Act 1985* to undertake a drink-driving rehabilitation course is £75.

### **4 Revocation**

The Road Traffic (Drink-Driving Rehabilitation Courses) (Fees) Order 2007<sup>2</sup> is revoked.

*EXPLANATORY NOTE*

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

The Road Traffic (Drink-Driving Rehabilitation Courses) Regulations 1993 (SD 106/93) designates alcohol rehabilitation courses for convicted drink drivers that are required to be undertaken further to a court order under paragraph 11(8) of Schedule 3 to the Road Traffic Act 1985, and the form of certification to be issued on completion of the course.

This Order increases the fee from £60 to £75 per person per course and accordingly revokes the Road Traffic (Drink-Driving Rehabilitation Courses) (Fees) Order 2007 (SD 518/07).
