## **TOURIST TROPHY MOTORCYCLE RACES (SUSPENSION OF ENACTMENTS) ORDER 2013**

*Made:* 22 May 2013  
*Coming into Operation:* 22 May 2013

The Department of Infrastructure makes the following Order under section 7 of the Road Races Act 1982.

### **1 Title**

This Order is the Tourist Trophy Motorcycle Races (Suspension of Enactments) Order 2013.

### **2 Commencement**

This Order comes into operation on 22 May 2013.

### **3 Interpretation**

In this Order—

“**closure period**”, “**Clerk of the Course**” and “**Course**” have the same meanings as in the Road Race Order;

“**Road Race Order**” means the Road Races (Tourist Trophy Motorcycle Races) Order 2013.

### **4 Suspension of certain road traffic enactments for motorcycles used for racing**

- (1) This article applies to a motorcycle, with or without a sidecar, which does not comply with the requirements of the following Orders—
- (a) Section 5 (using vehicle without vehicle licence) and section 12 (display of registration mark) of the Licensing and Registration of Vehicles Act 1985 in so far as those sections apply to a vehicle specified in paragraph (2), are suspended for the periods specified in paragraph (3).

- (2) The use on roads of a motorcycle which is competing in a motorcycle race authorised by article 4 or 5 of the Road Races Order, and is being used on the day of that race on a journey—
- (a) travelling from the place where it is kept to the start of the Course;
  - (b) travelling between the place where it is kept and a point on the Course;
  - (c) travelling from a point on the Course to the place where it is kept; or
  - (d) travelling between points on the Course,
- is subject to the restrictions and conditions specified in paragraph (3).

- (3) The authorisation applies to—
- (a) the closure periods referred to in article 3, and
  - (b) during a period commencing 3 hours before any practice period or race period and ending 2 hours after that practice period or race period.
- (4) The use on roads of a motorcycle specified in 4(2) or other vehicle specified in article 5 and is being used on a journey to or from the port to the place where it is kept.

## **5 Suspension of certain road traffic enactments for support vehicles**

- (1) This article applies to vehicles controlled by the promoter or organiser of the TT Festival or Isle of Man Constabulary which do not comply with the requirements of the following Orders—
- Section 5 (using vehicle without vehicle licence) and section 12 (display of registration mark) of the Licensing and Registration of Vehicles Act 1985 are suspended for the period specified in article 6 insofar as those sections which apply to a vehicle specified in article 5(1).

## **6 Duration**

This Order will continue in force for the period 22 May 2013 up to and including 8 June 2013.

***EXPLANATORY NOTE******(This note is not part of the Order)***

This Order exempts TT competitors, travelling marshals and support vehicles from the provisions of sections 5 (using vehicle without vehicle licence) and 12 (display of registration mark) of the Licensing and Registration of Vehicles Act 1985 when they are making certain journeys and during certain periods during the 2013 TT Festival.
