LICENSING (EVIDENCE OF AGE) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2013

Approved by Tynwald: 18 June 2013
Coming into Operation: 1 July 2013

The Department of Home Affairs makes the following Regulations under section 23(8) of the Licensing Act 1995.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Licensing (Evidence of Age) (Amendment) Regulations 2013.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald, these Regulations come into operation on 1 July 2013.¹

3 Amendment of the Licensing (Evidence of Age) Regulations 2009

The Licensing (Evidence of Age) Regulations 2009² are amended as follows.

4 Regulation 3 (Evidence of Age) amended

- (1) Regulation 3 is amended as follows.
- (2) For paragraph (e) substitute —
 - ☐(e) a card of the design depicted in Schedule 3 which is issued by the Department of Community, Culture and Leisure ☐.
- (3) Delete paragraph (f).
- (4) In paragraph (g) for “Foreign National Identity Card” substitute ☐Biometric Residence Permit ☐.

BIOMETRIC RESIDENCE PERMIT.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Licensing (Evidence of Age) Regulations 2009 [SD 869/09] in order to make provision for the new Proof of Age Card issued by the Department of Community, Culture and Leisure to be used as proof of age in licensed premises.

In addition, the Licensing (Evidence of Age) Regulations 2009 have been amended to remove references to defunct UK national identity cards as well as accounting for the change of title for the “Foreign National Identity Card” to the “Biometric Residence Permit”.
