TREE FELLING LICENCE (FEES) ORDER 2013

Approved by Tynwald: 9 July 2013
Coming into Operation: 1 August 2013

The Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture makes the following Order under section 1(1) of the Fees and Duties Act 1989.

1 Title

This Order is the Tree Felling Licence (Fees) Order 2013.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald, this Order comes into operation on 1 August 2013¹.

3 Interpretation

In this Order “**tree felling licence**” means a licence issued by the Department under section 5 of the Tree Preservation Act 1993 for a tree to be cut down, uprooted or destroyed.

4 Fee for a tree felling licence

The fee for the issue of a tree felling licence is £20.

5 Exemption for emergency works

Despite article 4, no fee is payable in respect of a tree which, due to its unstable or dangerous condition, poses a threat to persons or property and requires immediate felling.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order sets the fee payable for the issue of a licence by the Department for a tree to be cut down, uprooted or destroyed. The licence fee is waived in respect of a tree which is posing a threat to persons or property due to its being in an unstable or dangerous condition at the time of application for felling.
