REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS (FEES) REGULATIONS 2013

Approved by Tynwald: 9 July 2013
Coming into Operation: 5 August 2013

The Treasury makes the following Regulations under sections 15(1), 16(1) and (2), 26(3) and (5), 34(3), 35(2), 36(1) and (3), 37(1) and 43(2) of the Civil Registration Act 1984 and section 51 of the Marriage Act 1984.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Registration of Births and Deaths (Fees) Regulations 2013.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald, these Regulations come into operation on 5 August 2013¹.

3 Fees

The fees specified in column 3 of the table set out in the Schedule are payable in respect of the matters specified in column 2. Column 1 of the table specifies the relevant sections of legislation under which the matters fall.

4 Revocation

The Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages (Fees) Regulations 2008² are revoked.

*EXPLANATORY NOTE**(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations are made by the Treasury under the Civil Registration Act 1984 and prescribe the fees payable in respect of the registration of births and deaths, the supply of copies of entries in the registers and related matters. The Regulations that previously prescribed the fees (and those relating to marriages which are now prescribed in separate Regulations) are revoked.
