Payment of Members' Expenses Act 1989

MEMBERS OF TYNWALD (ANNUAL SUMS)(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2021

Approved by Tynwald: 18 May 2021

Coming into operation in accordance with paragraph 2

The Treasury, after consultation with the Standing Committee of Tynwald on Emoluments¹, makes the following Order under sections 1, 2, 6(1) and (2A) of the Payment of Members' Expenses Act 1989.

1 Title

This Order is the Members of Tynwald (Annual Sums)(Amendment) Order 2021².

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald, this Order comes into operation on 1 July 2021³.

3 Interpretation

In this Order—

“**the Act**” means the Payment of Members' Expenses Act 1989;

“**member**” means a Member of Tynwald, excluding HM Attorney General and the Lord Bishop; and

“**the Public Services Commission**” means the Commission established by section 4 of the Public Services Commission Act 2015.

4 Amendment of the Members of Tynwald (Annual Sums) Order 2014

(1) The Members of Tynwald (Annual Sums) Order 2014⁴ is amended as follows.

(2) Article 3 (Annual payments to members of Tynwald) is substituted as follows—

3 Annual payments to members of Tynwald

- (1) The annual sum payable to a Member of the House of Keys and the President of Tynwald is the amount at the mid-point between spine points 40 and 41 of the Public Services Commission Pay Scales, as determined by the Public Services Commission, as that pay scale has effect from time to time.
 - (2) The annual sum payable to a Member of the Legislative Council, excluding a Member of the Legislative Council elected as the President of Tynwald, is the amount at spine point 39 of the Public Services Commission Pay Scales, as determined by the Public Services Commission, as that pay scale has effect from time to time.
 - (3) Subject to paragraph 4 the annual sum payable to a member in accordance with paragraphs (1) or (2) who holds an office specified in column 1 of the table set out in the Schedule is subject to the percentage increase specified in column 2 of the table for that office holder.
 - (4) The annual sum payable to a member who occupies more than one office specified in the table set out in the Schedule is increased by the highest applicable percentage increase only. **22**.
- (3) Article 4 (Payments to the chairmen of certain Statutory Boards) is amended as follows—

4 Annual payments to the chairmen of certain Statutory Boards

- (1) Subject to paragraph (2) the annual sum payable to a member in accordance with article 3(1) or 3(2) who is a chairman of a Statutory Board specified in column 1 of the table set out in the Schedule is subject to the percentage increase specified in column 2 of the table for that office.
 - (2) The annual sum payable to a member who occupies more than one office specified in the table set out in the Schedule is increased by the highest applicable percentage increase only. **22**.
- (4) For the Schedule (Additional Sums Payable To Certain Office-Holders) substitute—

5 Transitional and Saving provisions

Article 4 (Amendment of the Member of Tynwald (Annual Sums) Order 2014) shall only apply to a person elected or re-elected as—

- (a) the President of Tynwald;
- (b) a Member of the House of Keys; or
- (c) a Member of the Legislative Council

after the coming into operation of this Order.

*EXPLANATORY NOTE**(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order implements the proposal in relation to the annual sum payable to members as set out at Annex 2A of the Report of an Independent Panel on the Emoluments of Members of Tynwald [PP No 2019/0158] (the “Report”), in accordance with the consultation and transitional arrangements outlined at paragraph 55 of the Report.

Accordingly, this Order prescribes by way of amendment to the Members of Tynwald (Annual Sums) Order 2014—

- i. the annual payments to be made to members of Tynwald;
- ii. the additional sums payable to certain office-holders.

The amendments provided by Article 4 of this Order shall apply to a person elected or re-elected as the President of Tynwald, a Member of the House of Keys or a Member of the Legislative Council after the coming into operation of the Order.
